3 Applying for Admission

- Submitting Application Documents According to the University's Admission Procedure.
 - * **Online or by Mail**
- Application form, diploma and transcript, passport copy, proof of financial resources, recommendation letters (if applicable), language proficiency certificates, etc.
 - * **All documents may require notarization, Apostille, or consular verification.**
- Pay the tuition

4 Visa Application

- Applying for and Obtaining a Visa Based on Residence Status.
- Submit admission letter, standard admission permit, financial statement(Proof of bank balance), passport, etc.
 - * **[University Support]** Provides visa documents (e.g., admission letter, certificate of expected enrollment, etc.).
 - ** **[Student Responsibility]** The student must apply for the visa directly at the relevant Korean embassy or consulate.

5 Other Preparations

- **[Daily Life]** Dormitory, bank account, mobile phone, insurance, etc.
- **[Alien Registration]** Alien Registration Card (ARC) within 90 days after entry.
- **[Insurance]** Mandatory enrollment since 2021; monthly fee required with possible student discounts.
- **[Part-time Work Regulations]** D-2 visa holders may work up to 20 hrs/week (40 hrs during vacation)
