

# **HOW TO** PARTICIPATE









### ELIGIBILITY

- Middle and high school students enrolled in Korean classes or Korean culture classes in public school
- If you attended school in Korea, you must have attended school in the United States for at least four years.
- **Please inform your teacher** that you want to participate in this contest. Korean class / Korean culture class teacher must submit a recommendation form for you through the teacher's Google form. (https://forms.gle/RdxndPd6Wbci8K2b8)



### **AWARD CATEGORY**

- Hangul Grand Award (1st) \$500 Scholarship + Certificate of Student Interpreter
- King Sejong Award (2nd) \$300 Scholarship + Certificate of Student Interpreter
- Hunminjungeum Award (3rd). \$100 Scholarship + Certificate of Student Ambassador for **Korean** Culture
- Jiphyeonjeon Award (Honorable Mention) Gift Card + Certificate

Winners will be given the opportunity to serve as interpreters and public relations ambassadors at KECLA-hosted and sponsored events.

- June 15 (Sun) Presentation material due Only those who passed the script review submit presentation material in PowerPoint, Google Slide, or PDF format.
- June 28 (Sat) Final presentation review and award ceremony at KECLA







### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS**

- Teacher's Recommendation Form (due by 4/27) The teacher must submit by teacher's Google form https://forms.gle/RdxndPd6Wbci8K2b8
- **Application / Essay Script / Presentation Script** (due by 4/27) (Submit the documents using your personal email address, rather than your school domain email.) The Student must submit by student Google form https://forms.gle/6b33aUuZCsFaZ3B19





### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS**

#### • Finalized Presentation material (due by 6/15)

Candidates who pass the script evaluation are required to submit their finalized presentation materials (in Powerpoint, Google Slides, or PDF format) by June 15th to chungsarah.kecla@gmail.com

### **CONTEST PROCESS**

- Essay and PPT Script Evaluation (50 pts) 1st Review
- Final Review Presentation Evaluation (50 pts) 6/28 (Sat) 1 PM ~ 4 PM at KECLA







### **SCRIPT EVALUATION (50 PTS)**

- Imagine you are doing a presentation **promoting** the Korean culture you love to people without knowledge about the Korean culture, and write a script for your presentation.
- Korean culture example: modern, tradition, history, place, person, story, entertainment, technology, custom, food, music, game, etc.
- **Review criteria**: originality, clear reason, strong support, and overall writing





### **ESSAY SCRIPT EVALUATION**

- Two pages, Times New Roman, font size 12
- Be concise. Write in KOREAN or English (or a mix of both): You can handwrite the Korean part if you do not know how to type in Korean. If you handwrite it, please scan and upload it as a PDF file.
- Save your script as First Name\_Last Name\_School
- Submit by 4/27 (Sun) by Student Application Google Form (https://forms.gle/6b33aUuZCsFaZ3B19) (Submit the documents using your personal email address, rather than your school domain email.)





### **PRESENTATION SCRIPT EVALUATION**

- **Be concise**. You will be given **5min** to present your material. If your script is too lengthy, you won't be able to finish in time.
- Format: Visual PowerPoint, Google Slides, or PDF format that aligns with the script content
- Save your script as First Name\_Last Name\_School
- Submit by 4/27 (Sun) by Student Application Google Form (https://forms.gle/6b33aUuZCsFaZ3B19) (Submit the documents using your personal email address, rather than your school domain email.)



### **PRESENTATION EVALUATION (50 PTS)**

#### **Presentation Material**

- Those who pass the script review are required to submit their finalized presentation material (in PowerPoint, Google Slides, or PDF format) by 6/15 to chungsarah.kecla@gmail.com
- Kindly ensure that you submit the documents using your personal email address, rather than your school domain email.
- All the participants must use the KECLA device. Therefore, please refrain from using effects and animation.
- Save your presentation as: First Name\_Last Name\_School





### **PRESENTATION EVALUATION (50 PTS)**

#### **Contest Format**

- Must present at the in-person contest on 6/15 (Sat) 1 PM ~4 PM at KECLA
- 5 min Presentation Cannot exceed 7 min, including preparation and exit
- Introduce and promote the Korean culture you love as if you are explaining it to people without knowledge of Korean culture.
- Present in English, Korean, or a mix of both. (Extra points are applied depending on the ratio of Korean used.)





### **PRESENTATION EVALUATION (50 PTS)**

#### **Contest Format**

- You can use costumes and props.
- Review criteria: content and composition, speech delivery and accuracy, attitude, ratio of Korean used
- After the last presentation, the evaluation scores will be tallied, and the evaluation results will be announced.
